

Neighborhood Association Election Meeting - November 11, 2002

Meeting was call to order at 7:37 PM

General Announcements

Maj. Banda, commander of Zone 6 announced that he is placing Officer John Bryzgoria at Hosea and 2nd ave as a full time beat in response to neighbors concerns about crime. Maj. Banda also reported that a serial tire slasher was apprehended. The slasher apparently was cutting tire of residents around 2nd and Hosea as well as those of police cars in the precinct. Maj Banda would like to know of any comments or concerns you may have regarding the PGA Tour Championship. He will add your concerns to a after event report that will be used to make things better next time the tour comes to town. (2 yrs from now).
