* Atlanta's sewer system is old and needs to be replaced. Current estimate to fix sewers is over \$3 billion. - The main question to be answered is whether City of Atlanta residents will have to pay the entire bill or whether we can reduce our cost burden by obtaining available federal funds.

URGENT! WHAT CAN YOU DO. East Lake residents need to complete sewer survey. The purpose of the survey is to obtain views about how to fix sewer system. You can obtain a survey from Councilwoman Natalyn Archibong's office. Survey due by October 25th.
